

Attachment: Regulations of “Directions of Loans for Startup Funding for Young Entrepreneurs” regarding the organization of counseling courses, the principles of course-related certification, and special applicants

1. An applicant has attended start-up counseling courses (either physical or virtual courses) organized by the government or its designated unit, public or private colleges or universities (including their promotion departments and incubation centers) registered with the Ministry of Education or participated in activities related to a start-up for at least 20 hours or two credits in the past three years, with certificates enclosed.
2. An applicant with a certificate of learning disabilities or difficulties issued by the government or a medical unit may provide a certificate of having received start-up consultation or counseling from the government or its designated unit within three years without being subject to the regulations in item 1.
3. The formats of aforementioned certifications are not regulated, and the financial institution providing the loan is in charge of reviewing the name, course, study hours, and the authorized unit of the certificate issuance.
4. If an applicant is a person with a special family condition or has suffered domestic violence, please provide a certificate issued by the social affairs unit of the municipal, county, or city government. For workers affected by trade freedom, please provide a certificate issued by the Ministry of Labor. (In such case, the financial institution providing the loan may apply to the Ministry of Labor for an interest subsidy.)
